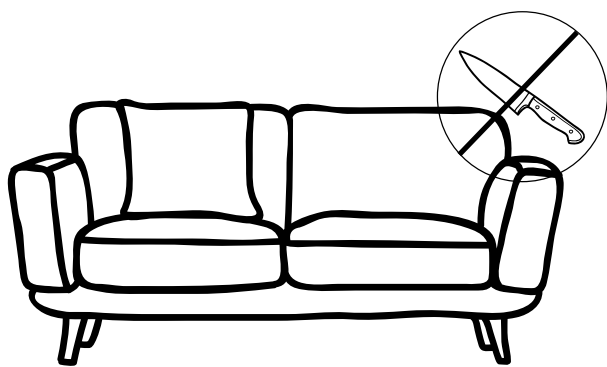


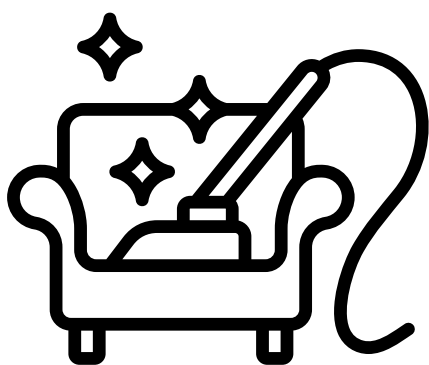

Unpacking

Unpack your upholstery carefully to avoid using sharp objects that can tear the fabric

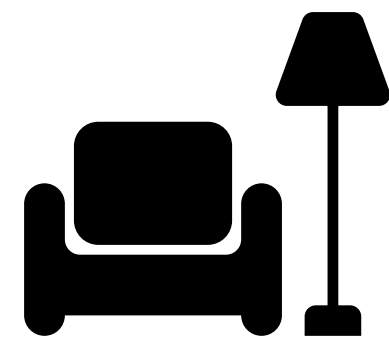


Cleaning Tips

Always clean up spills right away to avoid permanent stains. Check the tag on your furniture to see the cleaning instructions. The tag will have one of these letters:

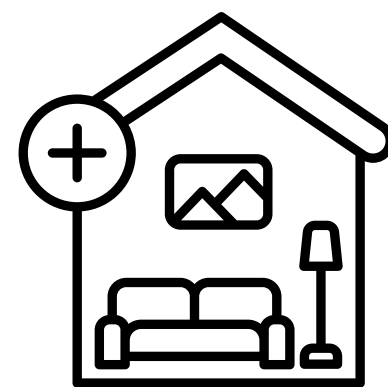
- **W:** Use water-based cleaners.
- **S:** Use dry, solvent-based cleaners.
- **S/W:** You can use either water-based or dry, solvent-based cleaners.
- **X:** Only vacuum. Have professional cleaners handle all cleaning.

NOTE: Consult your owner's manual if this information is not present on your tag.



Suede

- **Monthly Vacuuming:** Vacuum your suede furniture once a month to maintain its appearance.
- **Brush Off Dirt:** Use a nylon brush to get rid of dirt and food particles.
- **Yearly Professional Cleaning:** Have a professional clean your suede furniture once a year for a thorough deep clean.



Additional tips

- **Vacuum Regularly:** Remove loose crumbs & dirt by vacuuming.
- **Pet Owners:** Use a lint roller to pick up pet fur.

Preventative Care

- **Rotate Cushions Monthly:** Turn your pillows and cushions every month to keep them wearing evenly.
- **Protect from Sunlight:** Keep your furniture out of direct sunlight to prevent fading.
- **Use a Slipcover:** Slipcovers can protect your furniture, are usually machine-washable, and let you change your style easily!
